Special Olympics Virginia in partnership with Sentara Health, Special Olympics Inc., The Golisano Foundation and the CDC will be providing the Healthy Athlete Center at the University of Richmond on June 6, 2026 from 10 am to 5 pm for all athletes. Skin cancer checks will also be available for all delegation members.

What's available in the Healthy Athlete Center?

Special Smiles/MOM Project: The Special Smiles program offers full dental services including the availability to get your teeth cleaned or X-rays if you need them. The dentists will give you tooth brushes and dental hygiene supplies for free.

Opening Eyes: The Opening Eyes program will give you the opportunity for an extensive eye examination and the ability to obtain prescription glasses, sunglasses or sports goggles.

Health Hearing: Healthy Hearing will provide a full hearing evaluation and determine if your ear canals need to be cleaned with bothersome ear wax that can cause hearing loss and other issues.

Fun Fitness: There is a comprehensive fitness evaluation that measures strength, flexibility, balance and cardiovascular health. Physical therapists will give you valuable programs you can continue at home.

Health Promotion will provide an opportunity to educate yourself in sun safety, hydration, the effects of smoking on your body, body weight and BMI readings.

Skin Cancer Screenings will be provided by local dermatologists.
