Friday preliminary play for all sports

If for any reason you are unable to attend the preliminary events that are held on Friday for Tennis and Softball, we will follow the following procedures:

- SOVA will make every effort to fairly place you in a division based on the ability of all the teams/athletes participating.
- Regardless of the outcomes of competition, your athletes/team will receive a participation ribbon instead of a medal
- you must be able to field a team on the playing field during all rounds of competition. If you will be missing any players for rounds you must inform the Competition Director and divisioning team prior to the start of any play. Failure to do this will result in a participation ribbon.
- All events will be conducted in accordance with the 2020 Official Special Olympics Sports Rules. You can access these rules via our website at www.specialolympicsva.org.

Registration/Housing/Meals

Registration/Check-In

For Areas staying on campus, the Head of Delegation (HOD) should register their delegation at the Robins Center on the campus of the University of Richmond between 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM on Friday. The registration table will be located on the ambulatory level of the Robins Center. You may check into your rooms as soon as you get your keys.

Housing

- NO PILLOWS ARE PROVIDED AT THE UNIVERSITY OF RICHMOND. PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN IF YOU ARE STAYING ON CAMPUS.
- Housing registration for those staying at the hotels will be after 3:00. The hotel is <u>not</u> obligated to give you any keys before then.
- Keys will be issued to the HOD only, who is responsible for their return at the conclusion of the Games. Only dorms with actual keys needs to be returned- key cards do not have to be turned in.
- For those staying in a hotel, you must present a personal credit card for any incidentals. Please clear any outstanding charges for your delegation before checking out.
- In consideration of others staying in the dorms and others staying in the hotels, please help ensure that those in your delegation follow these rules:
 - There is to be <u>no running</u> in the hallways
 - Refrain from any horseplay and rowdy behavior in the bedrooms and hallways
 - Lounge areas in the dorms are for everyone's use. No one Area should "claim" it as
 theirs or kick any other Areas out of one they think should be theirs only. Most floors
 have only one common are and multiple SOVA delegations per floor. Please be
 courteous.
 - Please keep noise level down between the hours of 11PM and 6AM.

General Coaches' Information

General Rules

- All events will be conducted in accordance with the 2020 Official Special Olympics Sports Rules. You can
 access these rules via our website www.specialolympicsva.org. Modifications for specific tournaments or
 events are contained in this handbook.
- During competition, only athletes, meet officials, and assigned volunteers will be allowed in competition, bench, staging, or athlete holding areas.
- All athletes must be properly attired for the sport in which they are competing. Improperly attired athletes may not be permitted to compete.
- All Competition Rounds are MANDATORY. You must be able to field a team on the playing field during all rounds of competition. If you will be missing any players from any rounds, you must inform the competition Director and divisioning team prior to the start of any play. Failure to do this will result in a participation ribbon.
- <u>If you are not present at the start time of your competition/division, you will receive an automatic participation ribbon. If time allows and we can run you through the event we will, however, it is not guaranteed in any sport.</u>

Protest Policy

Protests <u>must</u> be submitted in writing to the competition director within 30 minutes following the specific incident by the coach.

A coach wishing to lodge a protest must fulfill the following requirements:

- The person wishing to protest must be the coach of the athlete or team.
- the coach must have seen the incident.

REMEMBER: Rule interpretations are subject to protest; judgment calls are not.

Athlete Entry Policy

Due to the Delegation Report that was sent out for approval, no changes will be accepted or made at the event. If the athlete has been entered in the wrong event on the original entry form when submitted by the Area, the mistake will not be corrected. An athlete in this situation may be scratched from an event if he/she is not trained in the event or due to health and safety precautions at the discretion of the management team.

Coaches' Meetings

The purpose of coaches meetings are to report any athlete scratches within your delegation, any last minute changes that have come up, and to clarify any rule interpretations that directly deal with the competition. At no time will coaches be allowed to add athletes to the competition that are not currently registered as an athlete or listed as an alternate athlete. Also, coaches will not be allowed to switch athletes into other events. The events athletes originally entered will be what they compete in.

Things to remember

- The coaches meeting will be a Zoom call scheduled for **Wednesday**, **June 1** @ **7:00 PM**. This call is your coaches meeting and you need to have representation from your area on the call. After registrations have been turned in, we will send out an email to all coaches who gave a valid email address with the call in information.
- There will be no coaches allowed on the pool deck during competition. During the Skills events, we encourage and will allow coaches on the deck. In addition if an athlete competing in the skills events requires someone to be in the water with the athlete, it will be the responsibility of the coach to be in the water. SOVA will not provide volunteers in the water.
- All concerns involving meet procedures or officiating should be brought to the attention of the meet director by the head coach to the protest desk.
- When checking your athletes into the staging area, please make sure to write on the athletes hand one of the following 3 options: W= Water Entry, S= Side Entry, B= Block Entry
- In the 25 yard flotation race, the athletes may use a Coast Guard approved P.F.D. in any position (prone or supine) that they are intended to be employed. You must provide your own Personal Floating Device.
- When entering the facility the following items are not allowed in the building: deck/folding chairs, no glass bottles.
- The use of t-shirts in the pool is discourage. However, t-shirts will be permitted as long as they are made out of a textile material and provide no competitive advantage

Recommendations for warm-ups

To ensure the safety of all swimmers during the warm-up periods, we ask that you read and practice the following suggestions:

- Swimmers are requested to leave the pool deck when he/she has finished his/her warm-up to provide other swimmers an opportunity for adequate warm-up time in the pool.
- During warm ups, lanes 1-4 shall be designated for one way sprints & starts. Swimmers may swim in one direction only down the center of the lane. A dive off of the blocks or a backstroke start is permitted in these lanes. Swimmers should leave the lane when they reach the end of the pool.

Things to remember

- If you lose or misplace an athlete's bib number, you must report to the athlete check in table by 9am on Saturday. At no time may you use an alternate bib number you might have.
- Starting blocks will not be used for any races. Track spikes may not be more than 1/8".
- Athletes who are blind or deaf requiring devices as listed under Article III, Section B, 1, 1 in the rule book are responsible for providing their own devices (rope or bell) and device assistants.
- Softball Throw- Athletes will be allowed three non-consecutive throws. Softballs will be provided. No personal implements will be used. An athlete who throws further than 24 meters will be disqualified.
- Shot Put- The shot put competition will be located across campus this year on the upper and lower practice fields. A shuttle will transport the athletes to the shot put location. Athletes will be allowed three non-consecutive throws. Shot puts will be provided. No personal implements will be used.
- Standing Long Jump- Athletes in the standing long jump will be allowed three non-consecutive jumps. Athletes must take off from two feet at the same time.
- Running Long Jump- Athletes in the running long jump will be allowed three non-consecutive jumps. Athletes must jump from behind the foul line and land in the pit to have a measured jump in the running long jump.
- High Jump- Athletes will be allowed to jump until three consecutive misses occur. Athletes must take off on one foot! Athletes jumping off two feet or diving headfirst will be scored as a missed jump.
- Pentathletes- The Pentathletes will compete over the course of 2 days. Friday the athletes will compete in the following events: 100M Run, Running Long Jump, & Shot Put. Saturday the athletes will compete in the High Jump & 400M Run.

Preliminary game format

- All teams are required to check in at the 12:00 PM report time listed in the above schedule. We will not be sending out a preliminary schedule to the coaches and area programs. When you arrive to the softball fields at 12:00 PM on Friday you will be told what field to report to.
- This year for preliminary play, you will be required to bat your entire team. After everyone on the team bats, you will switch. During each half-inning the fielding team will be required to substitute players who are on the bench. (A minimum of two fielders, must be substituted if the team has more than 10 on the roster.)

Saturday game format

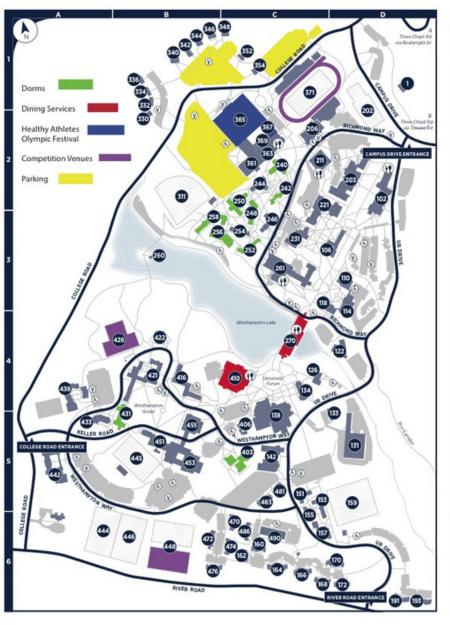
