Bocce Divisioning Instructions

All bocce registration must include qualifying scores for all participating athletes and unified partners. Additionally, a scorecard for use at practice and a video tutorial are provided on the Fall Championships Delegation Hub. Qualifying scores will consist of the following:

- A. Place the pallina at the 30-foot line, and the player should play (4) four balls. Measure the closest three balls and record their distance in centimeters.
- B. Place the pallina at the 40-foot line, and the player should play (4) four balls. Measure the closest three balls and record their distance in centimeters.
- C. Place the pallina at the 50-foot line, and the player should play (4) four balls. Measure the closest three balls and record their distance in centimeters.
- D. During the divisioning process, if the pallina is moved from its spot on the 30ft, 40ft, or 50ft, it is to be replaced on the spot before the next ball is rolled and before any measurements are taken.
- E. Measurements are to be taken from the center top of the bocce ball to the center top of the pallina, for a total of (12) twelve measurements, the sum of which becomes the athlete's divisioning score.
